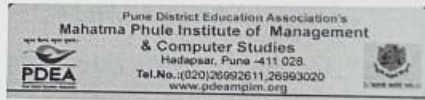

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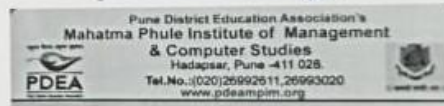


NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

5. Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings.
6. 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12. ExcelR would work with incubation centers/ innovation cells of second party (Case to case basis), to formulate the business cases and data collection process from various industry and academic bodies that are associated with the second party

Scope of MoU: To train and develop a "Data Scientist or Business Analytics/Intelligence Cadre for Public & Private Industrial Sector"

NOW, THEREFORE, THIS MoU WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. Aim and Details of the Programme

- 1.1 The Parties agree to collaborate to create and implement a training & internship program in business analytics for the brightest management students in MPIM&CS with the aim of creating a Data Scientist & Business Analytics / Intelligence Cadre for Public & Private Industrial Sector.
- 1.2 The Programme shall teach students (i) Typed Functional programming using R / Python script language (ii) Business Data analysis (iii) programming fundamentals and (iv) Tableau & Power BI fundamentals is of 6 (six) weeks duration and the first batch shall comprise of 20 students.



- 1.3 The selection of students shall be on interest and from a Joint Call for Applications by both parties.
- 1.4 There shall be fees to be paid by the students who are interested in this program.

3. Roles and Responsibilities of Miror

3.1 Miror would be responsible for end-to-end programme implementation Including Vision, strategy and execution.

3.2 This includes creating the course materials, admission criteria, student selection and course delivery through industry professionals and training the students for open-source contributions to BA/BI Network.

3.3 Chief Executive Officer, Miror shall act as Principal Coordinator of Miror.

4. Monitoring and Reporting Mechanism

4.1 Miror shall monitor the progress of students and share monthly reports on Programme Implementation with Institution.

4.2 Institution, at its discretion, shall use the learning from the programme to fine-tune its policies and schemes towards meeting policy goals outlines in National Education policy 2020 (NEP 2020)

5. Finance

5.1 The full cost of programme implementation shall be borne by Miror; either through external sponsorship or through internal resources.

- b. **GTT** will arrange for assessment of its own and also arrange external assessment as required.

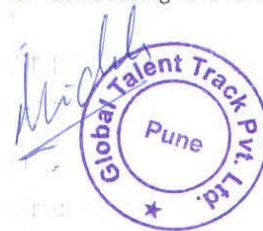
5. Other Terms & Conditions:
