Rules of Discipline 〈

- The Students are required to give the assignments, tutorials, presentations, as a part of internal assessment process on the specified dates.
- 2. Students are required to maintain of 90% attendance per semester.

- 5. Drugs, Smoking & Chewing tobacco, Gutakha is strictly prohibited in campus area.
- Using of Mobile Phone is strictly prohibited in campus area. Any student found carrying mobiles, the mobiles shall be confiscated.
- 7. The student should be regular in attendance and his attendance for the day shall be marked only when he is present for all the sessions during the day.
- 8. The student is required to submit their presentation assignment, tutorials in time. The failure in submitting the assignments shall be subjected to the disciplinary action.
- The vehicles should be parked on a place notified, vehicles parked elsewhere i.e. other than parking zone shall be confiscated.
- 10. The student should carry Identity card with him regularly and the Identity card should be produced when demanded by the authority of the institute.
- 11. The student found guilty be an act of misconduct either in the Institute or outside shall be subjected to strict disciplinary action and may be expelled from the Institute.

- 12. The student should not cause any damage to the Institute's property. The damage caused shall be compensated for the student immediately.
- 13. The students showing consistently poor performance in the tests and tutorials and failing in the internal evaluation of the subject shall not be sent for the University Examinations.
- 14. If the students are found weak in certain subjects they will have to attend extra classes as notified and make required progress to come at par with the other students.
- 15. Strict silence should be observed in the Library. Loitering in corridors is strictly prohibited.
- 16. The students coming late shall not be allowed to enter the classroom.
- 17. The student should read the notices displayed on the notice board regularly and the institute will not be responsible for the loss of any advantages due to the negligence of reading notices on the part of the student.
